

GREAT BROMLEY – PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY

Class	Description
Path No.1 Footpath	From road 200 yards south-east of Bush Farm in a south-westerly direction to the parish boundary with Elmstead where it continues as footpath 3
Path No.2 Footpath	From the road south of Harris Farm, in a southerly direction to the road south-east of Town Barn
Path No.3 Footpath	From the road north of Harris Farm, in a northerly direction to the parish boundary with Little Bromley, where it continues as footpath 15
Path No.4 Footpath	From the road south-west of Badley Hall in a north-easterly direction to the parish boundary with Little Bromley where it continues as footpath 17
Path No.5 Footpath	From the road north of Harris Farm in an easterly direction to the parish boundary with Little Bromley, where it continues as footpath 16
Path No.7 Footpath	From the road north of Raven's Green at the parish boundary with Little Bentley in a westerly direction to its junction with BYW 10
Path No.8 Footpath	From Hare Green by Portlands in a southerly direction to junction with footpath 11 and then on to Chapel Lane
Path No.10 Byway	From Hare Green in a southerly then westerly direction to the County Road east of Methodist Chapel. Was CRF. Re-classified (CA68) (Gen Mod 1986).
Path No.11 Footpath	Known as 'The Alley'. From the B1029 at the south-eastern corner of the boundary of the property known as 1 and 2 Chapel Row, Balls Green, in a northerly direction then east to junction with footpath 8, near Methodist Chapel. Note: Tendring DC FP11 (part) Gt. Bromley Public Path Diversion Order 1978 (HA59s.111). Confirmed 26/2/79 (Gen Mod 1989).

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Path No.12 Footpath	From the B1029 in a westerly then south-westerly direction past Cold Hall to Elmstead Road east of The Hollies. Diverted by Colchester, Eastern & Elmstead Market Bypass Side Roads Order and also the Tendring DC (Extinguishment of FP12 (part) Gt. Bromley). Order 1980 (HA59 s.110). Confirmed 10/11/80 (Gen Mod 1989).
Path No.14 Footpath	From Elmstead Road 200 yards west of Courthouse Inn, PH, in a southerly and westerly direction to Moreham Hall at the parish boundary
Path No.15 Footpath	From the road south-west of footpath 23 in a south-westerly direction to the road north-east of Strutt's Farm
Path No.17 Footpath	From the road to the east of Seven Rivers, in a south-westerly direction to the parish boundary where it continues as footpath 14
Path No.18 Footpath	From Badley Hall Road, opposite Peace Cottages, in a south-easterly direction to Lee Corner, Mary Lane
Path No.20 Footpath	From Hall Road, north-east of St George's Church
Path No.21 Footpath	From Hall Road, near Pond House, north-east to Carrington Road, east of Hazels
Path No.22 Footpath	From the road west of Cross Inn, south and south-west to the Elmstead parish boundary where it continues as footpath 18
Path No.23 Footpath	From Mary Lane North at Cowey Green Corner, in a south-easterly direction to the road south-west of Wright Kings
Path No.24 Bridleway	Known as Green Lane. From Briar Road, north-east to the parish boundary with Ardleigh where it continues as BR30
Path No.25 Footpath	From the road north-west of Red House, in a general south-easterly direction via Blue Gates Farm to the road west of Carrington Farm

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Path No.26 Footpath	Furze Lane. From the road near Union Place, east and then north to its junction with BYW 10
Path No.27 Bridleway	Cock Lane. From Stone Road north of The Chase, easterly to the road north of Park Farm. Added (Gen Mod 1986).
Path No.28 Footpath	From the B1029, opposite FP 12, in an easterly direction to Back Lane East. Added by Colchester Eastern & Elmstead Market Bypass Side Roads Order (Gen Mod 1989).
